Gorakhpur, February 28, 2023: The Department of Physics at Deen Dayal Upadhyaya Gorakhpur University celebrated National Science Day Week from February 24 to 28 in honor of CV Raman, who discovered a new radiation that led to the development of modern spectroscopy. The main highlight of the program was the recent achievement of a 3.78 grade by NAAC, and the faculty members made sure to emphasize its significance.
