

He said to determine which universities are producing the most employable graduates, our rankings considers five key indicators, including graduate employability rate and alumni outcomes. We at DDUGU stood under 100 in the QS ranking 2020 providing us a timely reminder to work cumulatively as a single community for students in finding out most suitable employment opportunity.

He praised this alumni function organized for the second time by the Department of Geography, where Professor K. N. Singh, former Vice Chancellor of the Rajarshi Tandon Open University and Professor Rajendra Singh Rajju Bhaiya University, Prayagraj, was the chief guest. With his dignified presence he further said that the department is recognized only by the alumni's achievements. Prof. K.N Singh said that the development of course curriculum should be in the light of *NEP-2020* that stresses application of geographical knowledge for enhancement of quality of life. 


Presidential speech by the Vice Chancellor of the University, Prof. Rajesh Singh ji






Prof N.K.Rana former HoD and Alumni Currently in BHU and Prof. V.N Sharma, BHU were sharing their golden memories with students and Alumni


